Stage 2 Requirements

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to warmly welcome you to a new year at Quakers Hill Public School and we look forward to meeting you throughout the year. 2018 promises to be a very busy year with many interesting experiences planned for your child. In order to help your child achieve maximum success at school, it is recommended that they have the following items as soon as possible.

Please note: It is not mandatory to purchase items through this website.

Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

- 1 packet of HB lead pencils (to be replaced as required throughout the year)
- 1 packet of coloured pencils
- Highlighters
- 30 cm ruler
- Barrel style sharpener
- Erasei
- 2 glue sticks (to be replaced as required throughout the year)
- Pair of scissors
- Whiteboard markers
- 1 Sharpie bullet permanent marker
- 1 appropriately sized pencil case to fit the stationery items listed above
- A4 lined book for homework (all classes except 34J)
- 1 A4 document wallet
- 1 large sheet of cardboard
- School hat
- Library bag
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Hand sanitiser or liquid soap
- Optional items: textas, gel pens, wind up crayons

Please note that items such as lead pencils and glue sticks will need to be replaced as required throughout the year.

Homework will commence in Week 4. Your child's teacher will provide more information about the Homework routine for their class.

Year 4 Bring Your Own Device

Following the successful implementation of the Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program across Stage 3 classes in 2016, Quakers Hill Public School is expanding the program to include Year 4 classes in 2017. Students who choose to participate in the program will be permitted to bring in their own devices from home to participate in learning activities in the classroom.

Should students wish to participate in the program, they need to sign and return the student agreement form prior to bringing in their device. The student agreement outlines the responsibilities and obligations of students and parents as part of the program. Full details pertaining to the program can be found in the school's BYOD policy, which is located on our school's website. Year 3 students will be able to participate in the program from Semester 2.
