National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy NAPLAN 2019

Dear Parents/Carers,

During May 2019, students at our school in Years 3 and 5 will sit the NAPLAN paper assessments. The schedule for tests is as follows:

The NAPLAN tests will be conducted from 14-16 May 2019.

On Friday 17 May, a catch-up day is scheduled for students who missed a test.

Exemption or Withdrawal from NAPLAN

Students may be exempt from the NAPLAN tests if they:

- are newly arrived in Australia (less than one year before the test) and with a language background other than English, or
- have significant intellectual disability and/or significant co-existing conditions which severely limit their capacity to participate in the tests.

All other students are expected to participate in the tests. Disability adjustments which reflect the student's normal level of support in the classroom may be provided. Access to disability adjustments or exemption from the tests must be discussed with Mrs Maruncic and a parent or carer consent form must be signed.

Students may be withdrawn from NAPLAN by their parent or carer after consultation with Mrs Maruncic. To withdraw your child from NAPLAN, a parent or carer consent form must be signed. Please make an appointment with Mrs Maruncic or Miss Ryan if you need to discuss your child's participation in NAPLAN.
