EDMODO, ONENOTE and SEESAW – Parent Information

Dear parents/carers,

This year we will once again be using Edmodo, OneNote and Seesaw in Stage 3. Edmodo is a free and secure learning network for teachers, students, and schools. It provides a safe way for us to connect, share content, access homework, participate in discussions and receive class information. OneNote is a free Microsoft product that allows collaboration and opportunities to present work digitally. Seesaw is an online student driven portfolio where students can share and collaborate on work in a safe, secure environment.

Edmodo, OneNote and Seesaw are both accessible online and through any mobile device with Internet capabilities – including free apps for iPhone, iPad, iPod and Android devices. Students can access their account from any mobile device or computer, and set up notifications within the app to receive alerts/reminders via text or email.

Edmodo, OneNote and Seesaw will <u>not</u> be used as a social network like Facebook or Instagram. These tools will be used <u>strictly for educational purposes</u> using the following guidelines:

- Students will be required to use appropriate grammar and spelling instead of texting language.
- ► These platforms do not allow private student-to-student messaging: all posts go to the whole class or directly to a specified teacher. Teachers receive an email notification of every post and reply.
- ▶ The platforms will be used to discuss school-related content only.
- No criticism or sarcasm toward another's ideas is allowed. All school rules and consequences related to harassment apply.

Students who fail to follow the guidelines above, and the items listed on the Code of Conduct may lose the privilege of using these platforms.

Parents can view their child's activity. On the right-hand side of a child's Edmodo home page, below the notifications section, there is a six-digit parent code. Once this has been accessed parents need to create an account with Edmodo as a student using this six-digit code. In this way parents are able to stay up-to-date with classroom activities, assignments and school events.

For Seesaw, parents will be provided with a secure code linked to their child's Seesaw account. This can be activated by setting up a parent account and linking to the code provided.

We look forward to a great year as we incorporate the use of technology into our classroom. If you have any questions, please contact your child's class teacher.
