Intention to apply: Year 7 entry to a Selective High School in 2021

Government schools use a range of strategies to meet the educational needs of gifted and talented students. One strategy is placement in a fully or partially selective high school, which provides intellectual stimulation and an educationally enriched environment for gifted and talented students. Offers for selective high school placement will be made on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 12 March 2020 at a venue to be announced.

If you would like your child to apply for selective high school placement in Year 7 in 2021 all applications are completed online.
