Mr Pugh has received a number of accolades in his career including, NSW PSSA Sports Service Award for his contributions to athletics in 2017, NSW PSSA Sports Service Award for his contributions to swimming in 2019 and School Sports Australia Service Award for his contributions to athletics in 2018.

Mr Pugh has been a NSW PSSA Athletics Manager since 2009, travelling with teams to various states of Australia during this period. He has been an advocate for athletes with disabilities competing in various disciplines. One of the highlights of his career is watching many of the athletes that he first managed now representing Australia at world championships around the world.
