This year we will be using Seesaw in some of our Stage 1 classes. Seesaw is an online student driven portfolio where students can share and collaborate on work in a safe, secure environment. It is a communication tool that gives parents/carers a window into their child's learning. Seesaw supports our students in developing important 21st century skills in communication, creative thinking, problem solving, digital literacy and citizenship.

Seesaw is accessible through any mobile device with Internet capabilities – including free apps for iPhone, iPad, iPod and Android devices. Students can access their account in the classroom from our digital devices and will upload relevant work. When there are updates, you can be notified. You'll only get notifications about your child's new journal posts. Parents will be provided with a secure code linked to their child's Seesaw account.

Seesaw will not be used as a social network. If you would like your child to participate, please return the signed permission slip below to your child's classroom teacher by 12 February 2020.
