Stage 3 The Big Dig: Pieces of the Past Excursion

Dear Parent/s and Carer/s,

As part of our History teaching and learning program this semester, our Stage 3 students will be going on an excursion to *The Big Dig.* Students will combine artefacts that they excavate from the simulated archaeological dig with other sources, to find out about the lives of people in Australia's colonial past, focusing on the Cumberland Street neighbourhood of The Rocks in the 1800s. They look at how the Australian colony developed, who the significant people were, and how colonisation changed the environment.
