Child Protection Education – Stage 2

Dear parents and carers,

This year students in Stage 2 will be involved in the mandatory subject Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE).

Part of our school's PDHPE program includes mandatory child protection education. Some of the content taught in child protection education deals with sensitive issues. The school will teach this content in an age-appropriate way.

Child protection education will be taught once per week this semester.

The specific content which will be covered in child protection education includes:

- Rights and responsibilities
- Rights and responsibilities in relationships
- Emotions and warning signs in different situations
- Power in relationships
- Male and female body parts and puberty related changes
- Positive relationships and support networks to manage change
- Gender stereotypes and expectations
- Types of abuse
- Bullying behaviour and strategies to ask for help
- Recognising and responding to safe and unsafe situations
- Strategies to stay safe and ask for help
- Communicating and cooperating with others in a respectful way
- Making informed and safe decisions
