



## NOTIFICATION OF EXCURSION – Nature at Nurragingy

An excursion has been organised for Stage 2 students. The *Nature at Nurragingy* excursion consolidates learning in the Science unit, *Living World*. Students will be provided the opportunity to immerse in a variety of hands-on activities. This includes surveying animals by viewing inside nest boxes and taking a guided tour to search for pollenating or seed dispersing animals. Students will also learn how analyse the diversity and abundance of species in an ecosystem to determine its health. On the day, students will participate in conducting scientific test to analyse water quality too.

Time: Students need to be at the silver seats by 8:40am. Students will return at normal school time.


## **Additional Information:**
