Year 6 High School Expression of Interest Forms

Dear parents/carers,

All Year 6 students require a placement confirmed for Year 7 2023, so completion of this Expression of Interest form is mandatory. You will receive a form to complete and return to school **on or before 18 March 2022**. Please read and carefully follow all the instructions in the booklet you receive.

Please remove the 2 perforated pages from the booklet ready to return (we do not require the information pages). Do not staple the pages - either use a paper clip or place pages into a plastic sleeve.

Your child's name has been entered onto the form and, according to our most recent residential school information for your child, their designated high school has been entered. **You cannot change or cross-out** this information on the form. If your personal details are different to our school information, you will need to contact the school office to provide proof in order for a change to occur.

1. Complete all other personal information in **Section A**.
2. If you are happy to send your child to the designated school (and you have not applied for selective high school) then you sign **Section B** and return the form to the front office.
3. If you do not wish your child to attend their designated high school, then **DO NOT SIGN** Section B.
4. **Section C** is where you may list 1-3 other government high schools (NOT selective or Non-Government schools).
5. If you list any schools in this section, you will need to provide an appropriate reason in the corresponding part of **Section C** (examples are provided in your booklet). If you have completed this section, you need to sign within Section C- parent/carer signature, then return your form to the office.
6. **Section D** - if your child has applied for an Academically Selective School placement, tick the box. You must complete/sign either Section B, C or E if you have ticked this section.
7. **Section E**- If you have applied for a non-government school in 2023 and have received placement information then you can complete and sign this section.
