Dental Screening for all Students

Dear Parents and Carers,

Quakers Hill Public School will be offering a free Dental Screening Service for all K-6 students at Quakers Hill Public School through the New South Wales Health Primary School Mobile Dental Program. The program will be delivered by experienced NSW Health staff from Western Sydney Local Health District, who will be using a combination of a fully equipped dental van and portable equipment set up on school grounds.

Important Information:

When: Monday 21 August to Wednesday 30 August 2023

Time: All day – Your child will be collected from class and returned after their assessment.

Location: Quakers Hill Public School

If you are interested in taking advantage of this free service, please complete the relevant forms contained in the attached Information and Consent Pack and return this **directly to your child's classroom teacher** no later than **Friday 11 August 2023**. **Forms cannot be processed after this date.** Please use black or blue pen to fill all the forms in the attached pack.
