

Early Stage 1 Requirements

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Kindergarten and what we anticipate will be an exciting year with many interesting experiences planned for your child. It would be appreciated if each child could bring all of the following items for their personal use and some to share with the class:

- 4 large Bostik glue sticks (glue sticks without a twist cap)
- 1 coloured A4 plastic document wallet (no display folders please)
- 1 box of tissues
- Hand sanitiser
- Packet of wet wipes- unscented
- Paper towel
- 6 black whiteboard markers
- Library bag (plastic bags are not suitable, school library bags can be purchased through the Uniform Shop)
- Headphones with students name clearly labelled

IMPORTANT: These items ARE NOT required for the first day of school. Please send them in gradually over the first few weeks of school.

Please note that items such as glue sticks and whiteboard markers will need to be replenished throughout the year.

<u>Uniform</u>

Students at Quakers Hill Public School are expected to wear full summer uniform to school; this **includes a school hat** and black school shoes. The <u>School Uniform Policy Implementation Statement</u> is available on the school website; outlining the school uniform guidelines. Uniforms can be purchased through the P&C Website <u>https://www.qhpspnc.com.au/s/shop</u> or the school uniform shop. Please ensure that all items of clothing purchased are clearly labelled with your child's name.

<u>Sport</u>

All Kindergarten classes will be participating in sport on Thursdays. Students are required to wear their sports uniform (including school hat) and appropriate joggers to participate in the planned sporting activities.

Library

Students will be given the opportunity to visit the library each week. Books must be returned on their library day before students may borrow again, and they must have their library bag at school. You will be informed of your child's library day once timetables have been finalised.
