Dear parents and carers,

This semester students in Stage 1 will be involved in the mandatory subject Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE).

Part of our school's PDHPE program includes mandatory child protection education. Some of the content taught in child protection education deals with sensitive issues. The school will teach this content in an age-appropriate way.

Child protection education will be taught once per week throughout the term.

The specific content which will be covered in child protection education includes:

- Showing respect
- Same but different
- My support network
- My body is private, and I can look after it myself
- Safe and unsafe touch
- Confusing touch
- Happy and unhappy secrets
- What is bullying?
- What can I do about bullying?
- My strategies
