# **Stage 3 Welcome Letter**

## Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to warmly welcome you to a new year at Quakers Hill Public School and we look forward to meeting you throughout the year. 2024 promises to be a very busy year with many interesting experiences planned for your child. A 'Meet the Teacher' information session will be held on Wednesday morning in Week 3. At this session, teachers will give a brief overview of the program for the year, provide information about online High School enrolment for Year 6 classes, NAPLAN for Year 5 students and answer any questions regarding the school year ahead. Individual Parent/Teacher interviews will be held in Week 11 where you can discuss your child's progress. More information on these events will be provided in a later note. Weekly parent information will be posted in each class Seesaw. If you have any concerns regarding your child please contact the class teacher, to arrange a suitable appointment time.

In order to help your child achieve success at school next year, it is recommended that they have the items listed below:

- 3 blue ballpoint pens
- 3 red ballpoint pens
- 3 HB lead pencils
- 2 quality (Bostick or UHU) glue sticks
- 30 cm wooden/plastic ruler (not flexible)
- Assorted colours eg. colouring pencils, textas, crayons etc.
- 1 eraser
- 1 canister sharpener
- 1 packet of highlighters
- 1 packet of whiteboard markers
- 1 black permanent marker
- 1 black fine line pen
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 Geometry set
- 1 A3 spiral bound Visual Arts Diary
- 1 small/medium pencil case
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packets of antibacterial wipes
- 1 container of hand sanitiser
- 1 roll of paper towel
- 1 set of headphones (in a zip lock bag labelled with your child's name, not bluetooth) to be kept at school

All pencil case items are to be clearly labelled with your child's name and brought to school on Day 1, 2024. Please note that items will need to be replenished as required throughout the year.

# Homework

Homework will begin in Week 4. Students will receive homework each week/ fortnight according to classroom teacher instructions. The children will have access to class OneNote and Microsoft Teams and other platforms as per teacher instructions.

# **Sport**

All Stage 3 classes will be participating in sport on Fridays. Students are required to wear their sports uniform (including school hat) and appropriate joggers to participate in the planned sporting activities.

# Library

Students will be given the opportunity to visit the library each week. Books must be returned on their library day before students may borrow again, and they must have their library bag at school. Students will be informed of their library day once timetables have been finalised.



# **Mobile Phones and Smart Watches**

Whilst students are asked not to bring mobile phones and smart watches to school, we understand that it may be necessary for them to use a phone or communication device before or after school. Any mobile phone or smart watch brought to school must remain switched off in the students' bag and it is not to be used on the school grounds or during school hours. Quakers Hill Public School is under no obligation to provide storage facilities for student devices and the school takes no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged devices while in transit to, or on school grounds. Students are not allowed to use digital devices in the following spaces under any circumstances: playground during recess and lunch or before and after school, toilets, while on excursions or other school events or when representing the school in sport or other extracurricular activities.
